

William Cox's diary entry, 23 July 1814

Saturday 23rd July

Hard Frost & Clear Weather

Sent see the Provisions. Took a
to a Hunt on the Banks of the left
side of the River, which Hunt is fitted
up to receive our Provisions as they
arrive from Sydney.

gave the Blacksmith his Tools
Iron & Steel, &c. &c.

Lorain who was hurt yesterday
very much better;

Took to the Governor for 2 Iron
Pit Saws, Iron & Steel.

Examined the ground leading
from Long Plains & fixed on the
spot to cross the Creek at, so well
as one to begin ascending the Mountain.

The Soldiers with Gorman &
Kelley all went for Long Plains
this day.
